LUKOIL TO SUPPORT SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OF
ELEVEN TERRITORIES IN YUGRA

Vagit Alekperov, OAO LUKOIL President, and Natalya Komarova, Governor of the Khanty-Mansi Autonomous Okrug (district), signed a supplement agreement to the cooperation agreement between the oil company and the KhMAO-Yugra government, in Kogalym today.

As part of the agreement, the company will invest in the social and economic development of 11 territories of the Khanty-Mansi Autonomous Okrug in 2015. Underway in Kogalym is reconstruction of a municipal out-patient hospital, construction of a 16-story residential house and completion of the Victory Park. In Langepas, a water sports complex, the Neftyanik (oilman), and a garden square, Molodozheny (newlyweds), will be constructed. In Urai, a biathlon center. The face of the city hospital will be repaired and a ski resort will be designed in Pokachi. Obelisks will be created with the support of the oilmen for the Victory Park in Mezhdurechensky Urban Settlement of Kondinsky District.

The construction of the third stage of the city stadium and an indoor ice rink with synthetic ice will be launched in Sovetsk, a cultural and sports complex with a library and a multi-purpose game arcade will be constructed in the village of Yarki in the Khanty-Mansi District, while a leisure center will be built in Oktyabrskoye settlement to include a recreation complex, a children's music school, a library and a museum. In the Beloyarsky District, the embankment will be reconstructed. In the village of Russkinskaya, Victory Square will be redeveloped and a field for national sports constructed, while a gas-boiler house will be constructed in Agan settlement of the Nizhnevartovsk District.

The Cooperation Agreement between OAO LUKOIL and the Government of the Yamalo-Nenets Autonomous District was signed on October 25, 2013. The document shall be valid for five years.
